

List of Common Dangerous Goods

The following is a list of common dangerous goods which may be able to be transported by air *depending on packaging and document requirements*. All vehicles and equipment must be drained of fuel before being offered for transport.

Self-propelled vehicles:

- ATV (Quad, 4X4's)
- Snowmobile
- Dirt Bike
- Side-by-side

Flammables:

- Aerosols
- Glues and Adhesives
- Paint

Fuel Powered Equipment:

- Generator
- Water Pump
- Motors of Any Kind (Vehicle or equipment)
- Chainsaw
- Lawnmower

Compressed Gases:

- Bear Spray
- First Aid Kits with Oxygen
- Welding Gases (Oxygen, Acetylene, Nitrogen, Helium)
- Fire Extinguishers

Fuels:

- Camping Fuel
- Propane
- Drummed Fuel
- "Jerry Cans"
- Marine Fuel Containers
- Kerosene
- Lighter Fluid

Corrosives:

- Hypochlorite Solution
- Cleaning Chemicals (Bleach, Industrial Grill Cleaner)
- Battery Acid

Batteries:

- Lead Acid Batteries (Vehicle Batteries)
- Lithium Ion Batteries (Cordless Tool Batteries, Laptop Batteries)

Explosives:

- Ammunition for Firearms
- Bear Bangers
- Flares
